We are pleased to announce that the Summer Music School will again be available to all students and adults in Warren County. Certified teachers will staff this program June 14—July 2, 2010.

Classes will be scheduled Monday-Friday 8:30 A.M. to 12:15 P.M. at Warren Area Elementary Center. All students will select five classes, one of which must be an instrumental or vocal class. We encourage adults to attend and enjoy learning with the school students. Eligibility begins with students entering fifth grade.
